DYE TESTING / CERTIFICATION
PROCEDURE

DYE TESTING

1. Fill out the top portion of the attached Request for Dye Test form leaving the plumber's portion blank and submit a copy of it to Union Township with a \$150 check made payable to Union Township. Send both the check and the copy of the form to:

2. Contact one of the plumbers on the Township's Authorized Plumbers List to perform the required dye test and provide him with the partially-completed Request for Dye Test application form. Once the plumber does the dye test and fully completes and signs the bottom portion of the form (Plumber's Report) which says whether the applicant passed or failed and, if applicable, the reason for the failure, provide the completed form to the Township Office. If you choose to fax the form, the number is (724) 348-9400. The Township will pay the plumber the dye test fee when it receives the completed and signed application form. If the property has passed, a dye test certification letter will be issued.
3. If the property fails the dye test, it is the responsibility of the property owner to perform the recommended repairs, request a re-test, and pay the re-test fee of \$75. Although the property owner can have the repairs done by any individual, a Township-authorized plumber is required for the re-test.
