

Union Township Board of Supervisors  
Budget Workshop  
October 30, 2012

The Board of Supervisors Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Linda Evans-Boren at 7:46 pm. The meeting was held at the Union Township Municipal Building, 3904 Finleyville-Elrama Road, Finleyville, PA. Board Members in Attendance by roll call were Larry Spahr, Linda Evans-Boren, Brenda Cushey and Andrew Tullai. Also in attendance, Judy Taylor–Treasurer, Debra Nigon–Secretary. Mr. Parish did not attend due to illness.

Revisions to the 2013 proposed Budget were reviewed in terms of the assignment of funds per GASB requirements.

The Board reviewed the funding for the police coverage by Southwest Regional Police in 2013. Mr. Spahr requested that the Treasurer prepare a summary page which would show the cost of police coverage, the funds which were being drawn from and in what amounts. The Board discussed possible options for future funding of police services.

Construction cost of the Emergency Services Sub-Station Garage Addition Project was discussed in terms of the Township funding the entire project in 2013 since a request for grant monies has been denied by the Redevelopment Authority through the Local Share Fund for the past several years. Based on the current estimate, sufficient funding has been saved towards the project. The Board will discuss the estimate for completion with the Township Engineer to see what the estimate includes and whether that figure is still current.

Due to a likely lack of a quorum for the Regular Board Meeting to be held on the second Monday of the month, Monday, November 26, 2012, the Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday, the Board decided to advertise that the November 26 meeting will be rescheduled to Wednesday, November 28, 2012 following the Multi-Municipal Plan Hearing already scheduled for that day but moved up to 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
